Brief description of fundraiser:

Rent-a-student works on a volunteer basis from club members. Club members go out and assist in whatever way the job they are “hired” for requires. This can be a huge variety of things from tutoring physics to raking leaves. Students get paid a standard fee for performing the job, and this payment goes to the SPS chapter.

Investment required:

No investment other than student’s time, and small amount of gas for transportation to the jobs. Generally the transit costs is very minimal.

Tips for chapters:

- Connect with people from community to hire students for these job, local alum’s work very well.
- Set dates early so students can be available for these dates
- Oftentimes we have an excess of jobs with not enough students to cover them all even with almost 100% club member participation.

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
