- Using your favorite browser go to the SPS membership portal membership.spsnational.org
 - Login with your chapter credentials:
 - Username: spschapter#### (where #### is your chapter number)
 - and

Share, collaborate, exchange and grow – that is why we are here. We hope that is why you are here, too! Engage and explore anytime, from anywhere there is an internet connection.

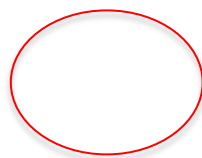

- Click on the ballot for your zone
- Click "Begin Survey" in the next window
- Each ballot includes at least two positions: SPS President and Associate Zone Councilor. Zones that are electing a Zone Councilor will have an additional ballot for those candidates as well.
- The ballot includes a bio and a statement for each candidate (SPS President candidates have three additional statements on involvement and experience.)
- Please vote by selecting the candidate of your choice
- Click "Complete Survey" to register your vote
- Please vote only once!
- You may see that some Zones allow for a write-in candidate. If you want to nominate one, please send a message to spms-membership@aip.org
